Sharrows are markings placed in the center of a travel lane to indicate that a bicyclist may use the full lane.



- Encourage safe passing of bicyclists by motorists
- Indicate the direction of travel for bicyclists

Reduce the incidence of wrong-way bicycling

Sharrows:

- Reduce the chance that a bicyclist will be doored
- Alert motorists that bicycles share the road



Bike-Friendly Kingston members have met with the Mayor and the DPW Director about the installation of sharrows in Kingston. If we are able to raise funds for the stencil and paint, we could have sharrows on Broadway this fall as a pilot project. Your contribution will help us reach our initial fundraising goal of \$5000 for 28 sharrows going in both directions on Broadway.
